Please find enclosed the final program draft and participant list for the meeting in Grenoble.

### Meeting goals:

- Train and discuss industrial soil and water pollution problems and issues, with specific focus on cyanide-based pollutions.
- Train and discuss the geogenic As and Hg pollutions
- Train and discuss 'soft' sanitary wastewater remediation solutions, with a visit of a rural water-cleaning facility.
- Discuss the presence of exchange researchers

#### **Practical recommendations:**

- For attendance to the meeting we recommend that transcontinental and UK participants arrive at latest Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> november in the evening at the airport of Lyon-Saint Exupéry.
- The transfer from the Saint.Exupéry airport to Grenoble city is organized at the discretion of the participants. We recommend the 'SATOBUS' shuttle (departure at 06.30, 07.30, 08.30 ... up to 23.30; 1h travel time), which brings you to the Grenoble railway station in the city center.
- We recommend the 'Hotel Europe' as host place (<a href="http://www.hoteleurope.fr">http://www.hoteleurope.fr</a> Located in the old city centre near to the tram station, the hotel is easily reached from the railwailbus station by TRAM 'B' (direction 'Plaine des Sports'), stop at 'Maison du Tourisme'. Actually, rooms are reserved for Kok Sothea, Dany Va and Bernhard Wehrli. To attend the university campus continue with the Tram 'B' in the same direction, exit at the station 'Condillac Université' (15 min. transfer time).
  - Hotel fees and travel costs (Airplane ticket, Transfert Airport-Grenoble, moving inside the city) are at the charge of the Calibre budgets of the visiting guests. This does not account for invited participants (BWehrli, SGuedron)
